CITY MANAGER:

COVID-19 Updates:

There is a pause on the Johnson and Johnson (J&J) vaccine due to very rare incidences of blood clots. There have been six instances of blood clots in women with over 5 million J&J vaccines administered.

Appointments can still be made for a two-dose vaccination by visiting <https://myturn.ca.gov/> at the Red Bluff Community Center. All Tehama County residents ages 16 and over are eligible.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Yost Park Playground Installation:

Staff will be meeting with the Contractor selected for the Yost Park Playground Equipment installation this next week to finalize the Contract and to schedule the equipment installation. After the meeting, a Notice to Proceed will be issued and work shall start shortly.

Water Service Leak:

A water service leak has been discovered at the intersection of Houghton and Marin Streets. Staff has called in the USA and will repair the line once all utilities have been marked.

PLANNING:

On Tuesday, April 20th, the Planning Commission approved the Use Permit for an Alcoholic Beverage License for Hometown Hub, a new Restaurant to be located in the Heritage Square complex.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 181 calls for service, a total of 27 officer reports were taken and there were 108 officer-initiated incidents, including 57 traffic stops. Officers made 15 misdemeanor and 5 felony arrests. Officers issued 34 citations, of which; 1 was a felony, 13 were misdemeanors, 5 were infractions, 1 was animal, 1 was unclassified and 13 were parking during the period of April 14, 2021 through April 21, 2021.

Training:

Officers continue to participate in POST Portal Training and Lexipol Daily Training Bulletins. Other POST on-line training continues for Patrol and Dispatch personnel.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Corning Volunteer Fire Department (CVFD) Call Volume:

The Corning Volunteer Fire Department responded to 21 calls for service last week, they consisted of: 16 medicals, 2 mutual aid fires with CALFIRE, and 3 public service.

Training for the Corning Volunteer Fire Department consisted of 13 members training on Ladder Truck 3 and extrication tools.
