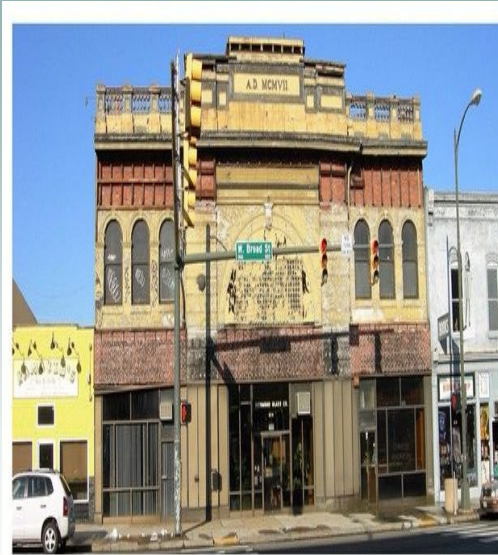


PURPOSE

The Façade Grant Program is designed to fund activities that will rehabilitate, upgrade, and generally improve the exterior building appearance and functionality within the City of Corning. This program also provides a City fee rebate for all property or business owners who initiate façade improvements within the City limits. Applications for grant funds may be submitted at anytime, however, a review and scoring will be performed on a quarterly basis.

HOW CAN WE HELP YOU?

Grants will be made for eligible improvements to buildings located within the City limits that improve the exterior building appearance and functionality. Eligible improvements may include:

- Storefronts;
- Display windows;
- Wood treatments
- Exterior painting and lighting;
- Awnings and canopies in conjunction with other façade improvements;
- Landscape improvements with an approved maintenance agreement with the City;
- Signs;
- Other improvements or planning costs as approved by City staff



City Fee Rebate

The City will rebate 50% of any City-related building permit and plan check fees to property or business owner not to exceed \$500. A one-page rebate request form may be obtained from the City.

Who Can Apply

Either property owners or business owners who own property or who lease property within the City limits can apply.

Maximum Grant Amount

The maximum grant available to qualified applicants is 50% of the improvement costs, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.



How to Apply

- Original online grant request
- Pictures of areas targeted for improvement
- A landlord Consent form (If applicable)
