

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was held Tuesday, May 9, 2017 at 6:30 P.M., in the Daniel J. Toomey Hearing Room, Town Hall, Danvers.

Present: David A. Mills, Chairman; Daniel C. Bennett; William H. Clark Jr; Diane M. Langlais; Gardner S. Trask, III

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.

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The Clerk opened the meeting and assumed the Chair announcing that he would accept nominations for Chairman for 2017/2018. A motion was made by Selectman Langlais nominating Selectman Mills; Selectman Trask seconded this nomination. On a motion made by Selectman Bennett and seconded by Selectman Trask, the Board voted unanimously to close nominations. On a motion made by Selectman Langlais and seconded by Selectman Trask, the Board voted unanimously to appoint Selectman Mills as Chairman.

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On a motion by Selectman Langlais and seconded by Selectman Clark, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Minutes of April 18, 2017 & April 19, 2017.

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New public business:

-Caroline Watson, Event Coordinator for Saint John's Prep requested a special public hearing for a one-day liquor license on May 20, 2017. The Board agreed to schedule a special meeting on May 15, 2017 prior to Annual Town Meeting beginning at 6:45 to allow open meeting law requirements be met.

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The Board was requested to accept gifts in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 44, § 53A of \$2,500 from Beverly Bank to be used for programs at Danvers Senior Center; a gift of \$175 from Danvers Garden Club to offset costs associated with planting of two trees at Great Oak School. On a motion by Selectman Clark and seconded by Selectman Bennett, the Board voted 5-0 to accept the gifts.

The Board accepted a gift of \$3,500 from Becky Kilborn, Danvers Rotary to Friends of Endicott Park to offset costs for nature center at Endicott Park. No vote was required as Friends of Endicott Park is a private organization.
