#### New Business

##### **1) 23-27 Locust Street**

Brian Farmer requesting painted parking spots and move the curb in for safe parking.

##### **2) 20 Wenham Street**

Chris Gaffney requesting the removal of a buried hump of a Town tree removed 5 years ago that is causing a site line issue for him backing out of his driveway. Forestry viewed the site and only saw the remains of wood chips, even with the grade of the ground. The existing smaller Norway maple trees are set back close to 6 feet from the road.

##### **3) 169 Summer Street**

Jeffrey Bird's driveway is on a blind curve on the North Street end of Summer Street. From the end of the driveway looking westerly toward the Prep, there's about 100 feet of view at which point two trees growing on his side of the road block that line of sight.

##### **4) Spring Street Traffic**

Gary Jones is requesting the following due to additional traffic to/from the Prep during school hours and on weekends:

- Conduct another traffic study that the Prep pays for but the results are submitted to DTAC
- Install more Speed limit signs
- More Police Presence (6:00am-8:30am) (3:00pm-4:30pm) M-F and randomly on weekends
- Install sidewalks from 62 on Nichols and Spring to the Prep
- Install traffic signals at Nichols and 62 or a stop line for those traveling east before taking a left into Nichols. And impossible to take a left out of Nichols onto 62.

##### **5) The Accessible Icon Project**

Cyndi McMahon is asking the Town to consider updating handicap signage at Danvers Schools

##### **6) Holten Street (between Sylvan & Cherry)**

A request from staff to eliminate parking on one side of the street from Cherry Street to Elm Street.
