New Business

1. Bow Street @ MacArthur Boulevard – stop sign at Bow Street

Mike O'Keefe requesting stop sign at Bow Street. Cars coming out of Bow Street taking left onto MacArthur Blvd (toward Rte 114) come out without stopping. May also be due to a tree on the corner of Bow Street which causes a sight line issue.

2. 1 Collins Street – No Parking Sign

Nancy Moore asked for a no parking sign in front of her house to stop patrons of Highland Variety from parking over/across her driveway. She has placed planters on each side of driveway to deter patrons from parking there.

3. Sylvan St (90) – Tree Removal

Francisco Bellini contacted DPW regarding the removal of a town tree which appears to be on his property and causing a sight line issue. The tree warden, Brian Richard, determined the tree is on town property and recommended he submit the request to DTAC.

4. Pine Street @ Washington Street & Braman Street – Crosswalk

Christine Watson requesting crosswalk on Pine Street @ Washington Street & Braman Street. She walks to McKinnon's.

5. Rail Trail @ Pickering Street – Paddle in the middle of crosswalk

Glenn Dagley is requesting because feels it would make the crosswalk more visible to the motorists.

9. Eden Glen Avenue – Request for Sidewalk

Briefing: Request for install of a sidewalk, discussed at June 27th meeting. Brett Gonasalves stated that a portion of the street is private/other portion public. There are several factors which would affect the installation.

Lisa McDonald has asked the committee to reconsider. She is requesting a sidewalk from her house #16 to Elliott Street for the safety of the 20 children in her neighborhood.

10. 22 Bates Street – Handicap Sign

Agenda item at June DTAC meeting. Letter was sent to Ms. Ruotolo asking she remove the handicap sign from the tree in front of her home. She is now requesting a handicap sign in the space closest to her side entrance which is her only handicap accessible entrance. She has had a state handicap placard for 10 years.

11. High Street (#148)

Request for parking space in front of home to accommodate 3rd car in family. Agenda item at June 27th Meeting which committee declined due to too many factors such as removal of a mature tree, relocating drainage, narrows the lane, creates a safety issue and others in the neighborhood could park in the space.

12. Holten Street Parking Lot

Bill Bradstreet request painting “Do Not Enter” at entry on Cherry Street.

13. Post Office

Bill Bradstreet request painting hatch lines in the opposite direction & a “no standing” sign.
