• **14 Tomahawk Lane; RDA 2018-01**

Mark Eisan, the applicant, is constructing a 20'x30' garage addition onto the right side of his property, side of property closest to conservation land. It will have a 10" thick foundation with frost wall and 4' thick slab floor. The addition is outside of the 35 foot no build and the 25 foot no disturb zones, and the farthest point of this addition is approximately 80' from the edge of the wetlands. Water run-off will be gutters and spouts.
