New Business

1. Princeton @ Perkins Street

Sean Hillier is requesting a crosswalk on Princeton Street. There have been a few near misses by speeding cars while children have been crossing the street for the school bus. Princeton Street curves and at the curve is a fence at 1 Perkins Street which may be a site line issue.

2. Chase & Hunt Street

Mr. Ozerkeo is requesting a 4 way stop at this intersection. Cars frequently speed through that intersection.

3. North Street @ Locust Street

Ann Tomes of 1 North Street is requesting either a “Blind Driveway”, or “STOP” sign for those cars turning left from North onto Locust. She fears that she will be hit when pulling out of their driveway.

4. North Shore Ave @ Adams St

Paul Cadoret is requesting a Stop sign on North Shore Drive at Adams Street. Motorists are speeding down North Shore Ave, this may cause them to slow down. Also feels that the double yellow line in the road contributing factor to speeding.

5. Maple Street (#308)

Paul Navarro of 308 Maple Street wants something placed in front of his home to stop cars from ending up on his lawn. The guardrail and hydrant in front of his property have been destroyed from accidents on several occasions. Sargent Shabowich will report on crash data.

6. Centre Street (#194)

Kendra Raymond requesting assistance for a resolution of cars landing on her front lawn from speeding/accidents. Forwarded to Sergeant Shabowich who checked the area and stated that there is a slight curve with a 25mph decreased speed zone. Sargent Shabowich will report on crash data.

7. Collins St @ Sylvan St

Jim Doherty wants to request a dedicated left turn signal for vehicles making the left turn from Collins Street onto Sylvan Street. He and his wife have avoided several accidents.

Old Business

8. 1 Collins Street

Patrons of Highland Variety are parking on the sidewalk in front of Nancy Moore's home. There is a "no parking" sign but may be too close to the corner. Engineering researching property lines for auto body shop at Centre/Holten/Collins Street intersection. Committee to triage & discuss.

9. Pine St @ Washington St & Braman St

Crosswalk request by Christine Watson, discussed at September 19th Meeting. Engineering to report on findings.

10. Back Bay PILOT – 25 mph

Sergeant Shabowich to report on PILOT program.

11. Perry Street Parking

At the September meeting the question as to the distance a car can park from an intersection. Also discussed at the meeting was if it was legal for the boat trailer to be parked on the street. Rich Maloney stated that he does not have jurisdiction over that unless not registered. Sergeant Shabowich also stated that it is legal to park on street as long as registered.
