Acceptable Rigid Plastic Components

Not Acceptable

-  • Plastic buckets *with* metal handles
-  • Plastic milk/soda crates
-  • Plastic laundry baskets
- Plastic lawn furniture
- Plastic microwave trays
-  • Plastic totes/bins - any size (*with metal*)
- Plastic drums (*any size*)
-  • Plastic toys & playhouses
- Plastic pet carriers
-  • Plastic pallets
- Plastic coolers
- Plastic shelving
-  • Plastic closet organizers and hangers
- Plastic dish drainers

- Plastic flower pots & trays (*no soil*)
- CDs, DVDs, VHS tapes (no film), cassettes and their plastic cases
- Infant/child car seats (*remove straps and covers*)
- Plastic traffic signs
- Empty plastic garbage cans (*any size*)
- Clear PVC & PET blister packs (*clamshell food packaging*)
- 5 gallon plastic water jugs
- Plastic computer housing (*no circuits*)
- Automotive:
Plastic bumpers, Plastic bed liners (*pickup trucks*), Plastic grills, Plastic side-view mirrors (*without glass*), Plastic headlight/rear light housings (*without bulbs*), Plastic hubcaps

- PVC pipe/tubing
- Vinyl siding
- Vinyl toys, inflatable pools, tents, etc.
- Plastic films/bags
- Glass; Metal; Wood; Paper; Textiles; Styrofoam
- Flexible water hoses
- Hazardous material containers
- Sharps/medical wastes collection containers
- Small plastic containers (Yogurt cups, PET/HDPE bottles, Plastics #1-7, etc.)
- Oil/chemical containers (HDPE-Fractional Melt)



* The Town of Danvers offers **RIGID PLASTIC** Recycling for its residents at the Transfer Station **Monday—Saturday** from 7:00 AM—4:00 PM (users must enter by 3:45 PM). There is no cost to recycle rigid plastic materials. **Items must be clean.**

TEXTILES can be donated in any condition as long as they are **not wet, oily, dirty, moldy or smelly**. In **any** condition, 95% of all textiles can be recycled or reused. NO carpets, mattresses or stuffed animals accepted.
