1. Sylvan Street/Collins Street/Federal Street

Stephanie Davis jogs this area frequently and concerned with pedestrian safety at this intersection. There isn't a crossing button for a walk signal or a sidewalk on Sylvan Street on the Collins Street side.

2. Briarwood Drive

Bill Clark received a complaint that there are numerous cars (17 in one day) parking along Briarwood Drive, causing visibility issues on Centre Street.

3. Old Burley Farm Stop Signs

Continued discussion regarding Ms. Urquhart's denied request for stop signs at Barbara, Mildred, Stafford, etc.

4. Donagle Circle

Ms. Fronki appeared before DTAC last month to request no parking at the top of the street but feels that the 20-foot prohibition does not address the issue adequately. She is now seeking to prohibit parking for a greater distance to protect the sightlines.

5. 1 Burroughs Street

Kathy Deluca concerned that parking at the building is being used by users of the rail trail and residents of Burroughs Street.

6. Crane Street

Resident concerned about cars leaving the long queue on Purchase at evening peak hour and racing down the street seeking an alternate route. (Sgt. Shabowich update?)

7. Conant/Elliott/Burley Farm Road

Ron Gagnon is concerned about the long queue at this intersection within the past few months. The cycles on the Elliott Street side are longer than those on the other side. Drivers are going through the red light due to the delay in queuing.

8. Bow Street @ MacArthur Boulevard

Cindy Cole is inquiring why the stop sign was installed on Bow Street and not on MacArthur Boulevard. The drivers traveling on MacArthur, taking left toward Route 114, speed around the corner without yielding for those drivers traveling from Route 114 toward Bow Street who are not aware that this is a two-way street.
