1. New Business

- **Wadsworth Street**

Colin O’Kane requesting “No Parking” signage on the entire street or one side of the street due to the width of the street. The uptick in traffic is probably related to the detour caused by the work in Hobart this spring and summer. DTAC declined a similar request for Clark St at its last meeting.

- **Princeton Street**

Chris Sawyer is requesting 20 mph for the street due to the increase in speed. Mr. Sawyer requested the same in 2018. DTAC declined to conduct a speed study and wanted to learn more about how effective the 25 MPH zones in the Back Bay area were.

2. Old Business

- **Old Maple Street/Hollis Road/Glendale Drive**

Jay & Leah Martel requested methods to create safer intersection for increased pedestrian traffic.

Hollis Road is believed to be private, Renee will confirm. Justin will provide information on extending curb, install of ramps on both sides, crosswalk, stop bar and stop sign.

- **Locust Street @ Graystone Drive**

Richard Stoney requested a crossing signal on Locust at the corner of Graystone Drive for those using the crosswalk.

Justin to submit written suggestions, explaining the install of advanced warning signs. Anthony asked Forestry to cut back trees encroaching signs from Madison Avenue to Graystone Drive. DPD to deploy trailer to collect speed and traffic data.

- **Sheffield Road @ Burley Farm Road/Stafford Road & Sheffield Road/Stafford Road & Burley Farm Road**

Dan Gagnon requested “Stop” signs

Justin to provide suggestion in writing, including all three areas. At meeting he did suggest deploying test barrels rather than going with short term painting or long term island on Sheffield Road @ Burley Farm Road.

- **Lights at Conant Street/Elliott Street/Burley Farm Road**

Anthony reported new loops being cut the first week of August.

- **Rail Trail Crossing (Maple St/Lummas St)**

Paul McNulty follow up on adding signs to guide rail trail users to this crosswalk.

“Paddle” was declined by Chief Ambrose due to the width of the street.

- **Alden Street**

Kelley Tree truck parking in street overnight. Aaron to revisit options to get this truck off of the street.

- **North & Summer Streets**

Selectman Bennett forwarded a complaint that a car is doing donuts in the street at midnight.

DPD has had a patrol out there for speeding complaints and will continue to monitor.

- **Newbury Street**

Request to change rear access to 240 Newbury Street

No comments were received from Capt. Brooks for the Planning Board.

- **Kirkbride Drive**

Stop sign is missing.

- **Neal Road**

Request for a crosswalk

Will be dealt with in the future due to the new developments.
