The Town Clerk's Office is announcing the mailing of the Annual Town Census.

Each household has been mailed their corresponding census form. The information preprinted on the form needs to be verified and updated if additions or changes need to be made and returned as quickly as possible.

Returning the completed census form can be done by placing the form in the enclosed pre-addressed envelope and either mailing it or using one of the pre-designated drop-off sites. Each household should respond within 10 days of receipt of the census package.

DESIGNATED CENSUS DROP OFF-SITES

1. Town Hall
2. Peabody Institute Library
3. Senior Center
4. Electric/Water Billing Office

The Town of Danvers, as well as every other city and town in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, is required by law to conduct an annual census. The information that is gathered will protect people's rights as residents and ensure that their name will remain on the voting list, as well as provide verification for the veteran's bonus, housing for the elderly and other related benefits. A simple response to the local census can prevent your name from possibly being dropped from the voting list.

Please note that you **cannot** use this form to register to vote or change your political party designation.
