ORDER OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH REQUIRING FACE COVERINGS ISSUED APRIL 17, 2020

On March 18, 2020, Danvers Town Manager Steve Bartha declared a state of emergency in response to the threat of the spread of COVID-19. Pursuant this declaration, the Board of Health issues this Order which imposes a requirement for face coverings in essential businesses.

- 1) All members of the public entering any essential business as defined by [Governor Baker's Covid-19 Executive Orders](#), including but not limited to grocery stores, pharmacies, home improvement stores and the like must wear a cloth face covering, such as a fabric mask, scarf or bandana, over his or her nose and mouth. The cloth face coverings recommended are not surgical masks or N-95 respirators, which should be left for medical professionals and first responders. - 2) All members of the public entering a restaurant for the purpose of picking up food for take-out must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth.
- 3) All employees of all essential businesses shall wear a face covering over their mouth and nose, and gloves, when interacting with the public and within six feet of a co-worker.

This emergency order shall be effective beginning Monday, April 20, 2020 and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
