NOTICE

As a result of sealed bids opened on February 6, 2020; a contract has been awarded to Woodall Construction Company of 182 Seekonk Street, Norfolk, MA; for the West Street Force Main Replacement Project. The contractor will be performing these improvements under the supervision of the Town's Department of Public Works.

The major components of the work will consist of, but is not limited to; removal and disposal of existing Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) force main and installation of a new Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) sewer force main, reconnection to the existing West Street pumping station, pavement milling and overlay.


Woodall Construction Company is tentatively scheduled to mobilize erosion control, heavy construction equipment, traffic control barrels and barriers, and begin construction during the week of June 8, 2020. The construction working times will be Monday through Friday 7:00am to 4:00pm.

The contractor will work closely with the Department of Public Works, Water, Sewer and Engineering Division to complete this project in a timely manner. Due to the nature of this type of construction, you may experience some temporary inconveniences such as traffic delays, detours, noise, dust and temporary obstruction of access to your driveway while the contractor installs the new sewer force main. **We ask that you allow extra time when traveling to and from your home to account for this construction, as you may be delayed by construction equipment working within the street.**

In advance, thank you for your patience and cooperation during the rehabilitation of the existing wastewater collection system. As the construction proceeds, we will keep you informed as to any changes or key milestones of the project that may occur.
