### 1. NEW BUSINESS

- **Select Board Approved Revised Traffic Rules & Orders**

The Select Board adopted the proposed revisions to the Rules on January 19, 2021. The document's official version has been posted to the Town's website and provided to DTAC members via email. We will need to make sure we implement these modifications, including:

- Revised parking rules on Mill Street
- No parking in the cul-de-sac on Electronic Avenue
- No parking at the end of River Street
- Changes near Town Hall, along Holten Street
- Parking changes along Locust Street
- No parking on Avon Street
- No parking along Lindell Street near the Recovery Center
- Stop signs at Hollis and Glendale

The Board has also asked DTAC to conduct more research on several topics, including:

- Construction Detail Policy
- Excessive muffler noise
- Sightline issues, particularly at corners and intersections
- Fine schedule (low)
- Confirm speed limit & signage (Ash & Purchase)
- Bicycle and pedestrian rules

- **Prince/Hobart/Centre Streets**

We received an anonymous submission proposing flashing no truck signs for the Prince, Hobart, and Centre Street area. Truck drivers are not obeying these routes and causing damage to streets, trees, and residents' homes.

## 2. OLD BUSINESS

- **Wenham Street @ Wildwood Road**

Roberta Mercier requested a crosswalk on Wenham Street @Wildwood Road. Review Justin's submitted plan.

- **Route 62 at Route 35**

Edward Lamphier requested to extend delayed light time for the west side, stop east from blocking left turn or make the left lane turn only on both east & westbound. The committee assumed that the requestor was referring to the unprotected left eastbound on Route 62 (Poplar Street) but needed clarification.

- **Hilltop Road @ Overlook Drive**

Amy Manley requested "Stop" on Hilltop Road and advisory signs for those entering the development. Aaron reached out to the developer but has not received a response. Review proper advisory signs for accepted portion install.

- **Endicott Street**

Nick Sheehan requested traffic signals/crosswalk boxes to assist ITW Performance Polymers employees in taking a left turn from Appleton Street onto Endicott Street. Committee to discuss options.

- **North Street**

Committee feedback on Aaron's written response to Mike Kasprzak's requests.
