2. Special Request

- Mr. White on behalf of Danvers High School senior class is requesting permission to remove/partially demolish the train depot on Townsend oil property.

3. Public Hearing(s) for Historically Significant Buildings or Landmarks

A public hearing is held to decide whether the demolition of a historically significant building or landmark would be detrimental to the Town's historical or architectural heritage or resources.

- **42 Summer Street (Continued)**

The property owner is proposing the demolition of the structure, a home constructed in 1700. The Commission opened the public hearing at its April meeting, at which the applicant requested a continuance.

- **367 Maple Street**

The property owner is proposing the demolition of the structure, a home constructed in 1841. The Commission determined it to be historically significant at its April meeting.

- **61 High Street**

The property owner is proposing the demolition of the structure, a home constructed in 1875 and proposing a mixed-use building for redevelopment per HSMUD. The Commission determined it to be historically significant at its April meeting.
