

RESOLUTION # 012-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, ADOPTING A POLICY GOVERNING FITNESS FOR DUTY EXAMINATIONS FOR SWORN AND NON-SWORN MEMBERS OF THE DE LEON POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1445 was passed by the Texas Legislature on May 19, 2023 which required the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement ("TCOLE") to prepare a model policy prescribing standards and procedures for the medical and psychological examination of sworn and non-sworn members of law enforcement agencies and required each law enforcement agency to adopt the model policy or a substantively similar policy; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Senate Bill No. 1445, TCOLE has prepared a model policy for adoption by each law enforcement agency; and

WHEREAS, the attached policy is a substantively similar policy to the prepared TCOLE model policy governing Fitness for Duty Examinations;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds that the premises and findings set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein.


Section 2. The City Council hereby adopts the attached policy governing Fitness for Duty Examinations as the official policy of the City of De Leon Police Department.
