### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF A RUN OFF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR PLACE FOUR COUNCIL MEMBER

**WHEREAS**, a election was held in the City of De Leon, Texas on June 7, 2025 for the purpose of the Run off Special Election of Place Four Council member.

# THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS,

SECTION 1. The City Council officially finds, determines, and declares that the election was duly and properly ordered, that proper legal notice of such election was duly given in the English language and the Spanish language, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to the election, that the election was duly and legally held, that all resident, qualified electors of the City of De Leon were permitted to vote at the election, and due returns of the results of the election had been made and delivered, and that the City of De Leon has duly canvassed such returns, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and of the United States of America and the resolution calling the election.

**SECTION 5**. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 10, of the Charter of the City of De Leon, the requirement for the reading the Ordinance at two (2) meetings of the City Council is waived.
