

**Rules & Regulations
Of
City of De Leon Cemetery**

All work upon the lots within any cemetery shall be performed by employees of the City of De Leon under the direction of the City Manager/Administrator or his/her designee, except when permission is otherwise granted by said officer. All grading, landscaping and improvements of any kind and all care of lots shall be performed, and all trees, shrubs, and herbage of any kind shall be planted, trimmed, cut or removed by such employees.

No enclosure of any kind, such as a fence, hedge or ditch, shall be permitted around any grave or cemetery lot or plot; provided, however, that a concrete coping or curbing may be constructed if the face of same is located on a property line. The width of any such curb or coping may not exceed six inches (6"), and the same shall be constructed so as not to hinder or interfere with the mowing or drainage of lots. Grave mounts are prohibited and no cemetery lot shall be raised above the established grade.

Should any monument, fence, mausoleum, or tomb in any cemetery become unsightly, dilapidated or a menace to visitors, the City of De Leon shall have the right, at the expense of the owner of the lot or lots involved, either to correct such condition or remove the same. Such condition shall be as reasonably determined by the City Manager/Administrator or his/her designee.

Said City shall have the right to remove all flowers, potted plants, summer wreaths or baskets when they become withered or substantially weathered, and said City Manager/Administrator or his/her designee is hereby empowered to remove the same.

Temporary markers should be removed after placement of permanent headstone. If not removed, the City will remove and store markers at the cemetery for a period of one year.

All monuments or markers must be erected or placed within the boundaries of the lot or lots of owners. Footstones shall not protrude above ground level.
