AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINATCE APPOINTING A CITY FIRE CHIEF,
DEFIGATIVE TO HIS CERTAIN POWERS AND AUTHORITIES
TO ORGANIZE A VOLUNTEER FIRE BEPARTMENT; PROVIDING
THAT ANY PERSON OF PERSONS OTHER THAN ATMETES OF
THE VOLUNTEER DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF DELECT
STALL NOT DRIVE OR OFFRATE A NOTOR VEHICLE CLOTER
TO THE FIRE TRUCK THAN 100 PERT WHILE SUCH FIRE
THICH IS AN MOTION ANEWERING A FIRE CALL; PROVIDING
THE THAT HO CAR OF OTHER MOTOR VEHICLE, WHATHER
AN OTHER TO A STUBER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OR
AN OTHER TO RECU SHALL PARK ON ANY STREET, SIDE STREET
OR IN ANY ALLY CLOSER THAN 300 PEET TO THE FIRE
FLUG TO THICH THE FIRE HOSE SHALL BE ATTACHED, OR
TO THE HIPF ITSULF; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR
VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHIREAS, in this time of emergency, while our Country is engaged in War involving the welfare and freedom of our people, if not their lives, it is deemed imperative by the City council of the City of Deleen that all precautionary measures be taken to guard against fire by sabotage, air raids and other acts of our enemies and enemy aliens in our mides, and

WHEREAS, in order to adequatedly provide protection for the inhabitants of the City of Deleon and protection of property, it is deemed tecossary that a Fire fighting department be organized to the best of the city's ability and within its financial means and Citizen pursued, and

WHEREAC, the city council has determined that T.M. Tilliams is a fitting an proper person and the most suitable person to head said. Fire department as its Fire Chief, and

powers and a thority for the organization of such department, and the command of its personal.

NOW, THE FORE, SE IT ORDATINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DELECH, TEXAS.

Volunteer fire department; such fire department shall consist of a Fire Chicf and such other personel as the Fire Chicf shall be able to command.

T.H.Williams is heroby appointed Eire Chief of the Volunteer Fire Department of the City of DeLeon, Texas. He shall hold office until his successor has been duly appointed by the City Council of the City of DeLeon.

3.

The Fire Clief is hereby vested with the power and authority to organize a volunteer fire department to receive the voluntary services of the citizens of Deleon who wishlto enroll for such service. He shall have the right to appoint a subordinate or subordinates and I live to them such rank or designation as may be fitting and proper, provided that such organization shall not be in conflict with the office of Civilian Defense during the period of hostilities now existing. He shall have power and authority to delegate to such subordinates such authority as he doems necessary and expedient under the circumstances of each case. If the Fire chief deems necessary he is herepy given authority to command the services of any male citizen within the coporate limits of the City of Deleon to assist him in extinguishing any fire or fires, and all persons working under the Pire Chief's command shall obey his instructions with reference to their duties. A failure on the part of any such person or parsons to obey such instructions or commands when given by the Fire Chief, shall subject such person or persons to the penalty to be hereinafter presented.

4.

/except members of the Volunteer Fire Department or other duly mix authorizlawful for any person or persons/to park a car or other mutor vehicle
ed city officers and/or officials
on a street, side street, alley, lot or other space closer than 300
feet from where the City Fire truck or trucks are parked for the purpose
of extinguishing a fire; or closer than 300 feet from the fire plus
to which the fire hose is attached, or closer than 300 feet from the fire
itself. It shall be the duty of every inhabitant within the corporate
limits of the city of DeLeon or other person, whether they be inhabitants
of said City or may be temporarily therein, to observe this ordinance
strictly in order that firemen may not be hampered in combating

such fire or in the performance of their duties.

or persons; except members of the Volunteer Fire Department or other duly authorized city officers and or officials or other fire vehicles at any time, who ther the same is loing to or returning from a fire, and it shall be the duty of every officer within the corporate limits of the City of DeLeon to prevent any such attempt to so ride if the same is called to their attention. Any person or persons so violating the terms of this ordinance shall be nunished as hereinafter provided.

6.

When the Fire department is engaged in extinguishing a fire or fires, and a fire hose is across a street, alley or side street, lot or open space, no person shall drive or operate a motor vehicle on, over or across such fire hose. Any person violating such provision of this ordinance shall be punished as hereinafter provided.

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not to exceed \$200.00.
