AN ORDINANCE: OFFERING A \$250.00 REWARD FOR THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF ANY PERSON OR PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF COMMITTING THE CRIME OF ARSON WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH SAID ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City of De Leon, Texas, hereby offers an "ARSON REWARD", as follows:

ARSON REWARD

THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, HEREBY OFFERS A REWARD OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) FOR THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF ANY PERSON OR PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF COMMITTING THE CRIME OF ARSON WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS. THIS REWARD IS A STANDING OFFER, AND SHALL BE PAID OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE: The fact that there is no valid and adequate arson reward ordinance now in effect in the City of De Leon, Texas, creates an imperative public necessity and demand, requiring that the rule requiring the reading of ordinances at two separate meetings of the Board of City Commissioners prior to final passage thereof, be suspended, and it is accordingly ordered that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon the necessary publication thereof, required by the City Charter. The City Secretary will endorse hereon the effective date of this ordinance.
