

ORDINANCE NO. # 005-05**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. # 014-02, SECTION 4, SUBSECTION C-2, PROVIDING
FOR MUNICIPAL COURT ASSESSMENT OF FINES AND COSTS;**

WHEREAS, Article 45.203 of the Code of Criminal Procedure authorizes the City of De Leon, Texas (herein the "City") to prescribe rules to enforce the collection of fines and fees imposed; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance shall apply to all offenses occurring on or after September 1, 2005.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 4. Funds. In addition to the court costs mandated to be collected under state statute for the State of Texas and remitted to the comptroller as court cost and as set out in Section 3, the following court cost shall be collected for each conviction as provided herein:

(c) Technology Fee

- (2) **Collection and Deposit.** The Municipal Court Clerk shall collect such court costs, including the technology fee, and pay such court costs to the City Treasurer for all offenses governed by the subsection.

The City Treasurer shall deposit the \$4.00 technology fee portion of such court costs into the "Municipal Technology Fund".


The collection of funds will continue so long as such fee is authorized and permitted by the State of Texas or this ordinance is amended or repealed.
