An Ordinance---

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF VARIENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE FUNDING CHRTAIN VALID OUTSTAUDING INDESTRUCES OF THE CITY OF DE ARON, TAXAS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE INVESTOR AND CREATE A SHRING FUND FOR THE RESERVENCY.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of De Leon, Texas, deems it advisable to issue Funding Warrants of said City for the purpose herein-after mentioned.

PHEREFORE THE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THE CITY

I. That warrants of said City, to be called "City of De Leon Street Improvement Funding Warrants", be issued under and by virture of the Constitution and laws of the State of Taxas, for the purpose of funding an equal amount of indebtedness of said City, duly and I legally issued, and which is a valid, subsisting and now outstanding obligation against said City, the claims for which were duly audited and allowed by the City Commission prior to the issuence ty thereof, and which is to be cancelled and the evidences thereof, and the warrants hereby authorized issued to the holder or holders in lieu thereof; which said original out standing indebtedness was issued against the Street Improvement Fund of said City, and is as fol-

- 6. Said warrants shall be signed by the Mayor, countersigned by the City Secretary and registered by the City Tesasurer, and the seal of said City shall be impressed upon each of them.

-tofore duly and legally issued against the Street Improvement Fund, of said City, the claims for which were daly audited and allowed by the city council prior to the issuance thereof, and for w which said city has received full consideration and value end hereby acknowledged receipt of came, and which indebtudness was authorized by ordinances duly and legally adopted prior to its issuance, bade and entered upon the Linutes of the City Council of said City; it being known and under stood that this warrant, as well as all others of this series, is issued for the sole purpose and intende of funding said outstanding indebtedness into warrants surhorized and issued and which are to be paid out of a special fund, made created and set out of the Street Improvement Fund of said City. designated as "SPECIAL STREET IMPROVEMENT FUNDING WARRANT FUND", which shall he sesessed, collected and set aside for said purpose; in accordance with the Constitution end laws of the State and in pur -cuance of an ordinance duly and legally pessed by the City Council. of De Leon, on the 24th day of June, 1919, which ordinance is recorded in Book 1, at page 102. et seg. of the Minuted of said City Council.

The date of this warrant, in conformity with the ordinance above mentioned ,is hereby July,1,1919; and it is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions end things required to be done precedent to and in the issuence of this warrant have been properly done, happened and performed, in regular and due time, form and manner, as required by law, and that the total indebtedness of said City, including this warrant, does not exceed the Constitutional or statutory limitations

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL that said original indebtedness hereinbefore mentioned and described be and the same is hereby in all things validated and held and declared to be a valid, subsisting and binding and unsatisfied obligation against said city, and the acts of the city officials in the issuance there of are hereby in all things ratified and confirmed.
- 10. IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL that a fund and the same is hereby made and created and shall be set saide out of the Street Improvement Fund of the City of De Leon, Texas, and shall be designated "SPECIAL STREET IMPROVEMENT FUNDING WARRANT FUND", which fund when collected shall be used for the payment of interest on said warrants, and the principal thereof at maturity, and for no other purpose: that to create said fund to pay the interest on said warrants and provide the necessary sinking fund to redeem them at maturitym a tax of and at the rate of 7 3/4 cents on the One Hundred Dollars' valuation of all taxable property in the City of De Leon.

out of the constitutional fifteen cents Street Improvement Tax, is hereby levied for the current year 1919; that during the year 1920. and each year thereafter while any of said warrants are out stand—ing and unpaid, and at the time the other taxes are levied in each of said years, there shall be computed and ascertained what rate of tax, based upon the last approved tax rolls, will be necessary, maxx requisite and sufficient to fully make, raise and produce in each of said years the amount of principal hecessary to be raised for that year, plus the interest upon the amount of this series of warrants outstanding and unpaid, and for each of said years there is hereby ordered to be levized a tax at such rate as shall be found necessary and sufficient, as aforesaid; and all such taxes, when collected, shall be appropriated and applied to the purposes named, and no other.

The fact that the City Council deems it becomes y to fund the outstanding indebtedness hereinbefore described, decreasing the rate of interest and postponing the date of maturity, creates an emergency and a public necessary that the rule meguiring ordinances to be passed at more than one meeting of the City Council be suspended, and soid rule is hereby suspended and this ordinance is placed on its final reading and passage and shall take affect and be in force from and after ite passage.
