

ORDINANCE NO. # 003-06

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS,
AMENDING SECTION 5; AND ADDING SECTION 11 TO
ORDINANCE NO. # 001-06; ORDERING THE GENERAL
ELECTION FOR MAY 2006.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON,
TEXAS,**

Section 5. That the following officials are appointed by the City Council to conduct this general election.


Presiding Judge- Shirley Wilkerson
Alternate Judge- Marie Nabors

The Presiding Judge shall appoint the clerks of the election in a number not to exceed (5). The Alternate Judge shall serve as Presiding Judge for an election if the Presiding Judge cannot serve. In an election conducted by the Presiding Judge, the Alternate Judge serves as one of the clerks. The Early Voting Ballot Board shall be comprised of the Presiding Judge and the Alternate Judge.

The judge and clerks shall be compensated at a rate of \$8.00 per hour. No judge or clerk shall be paid for more than one hour after the closing of the polls. The election official who delivers the returns of the election shall be paid an additional \$25.00 provided he/she also returns unused ballots, election supplies, and ballots boxed when he/she makes delivery of the returns of the elections.

Section 11. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 10, of the Charter of the City of De Leon, the requirement for the reading the Ordinance at two (2) meetings of the City Council is waived.
