

## ORDINANCE NO. 008-98

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1998, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1999, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 102, VERNON'S TEXAS CIVIL STATUTES, APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Secretary of the City of De Leon has submitted to the City Council a proposed budget of the revenues of said City and the expenditures/expenses of conducting the affairs thereof and providing a complete financial plan for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1998, and ending September 30, 1999, and which said proposed budget has been compiled from detailed information from the several departments, divisions, and offices of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received said proposed budget, a copy of which proposed budget has been filed with the City Secretary of the City of De Leon; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on the budget for the City of De Leon for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 1998, and ending on September 30, 1999, was published in the De Leon Free Press and De Leon's Monitor on August 27, 1998, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of De Leon has conducted a public hearing on said budget on September 10, 1998, at which time all interested citizens were given the opportunity to be heard on said budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON THAT:

SECTION 1. The proposed budget of the revenue of the City of De Leon and the expenses of conducting the affairs thereof, providing a complete financial plan for the ensuing fiscal year beginning October 1, 1998, and ending September 30, 1999, as submitted to the City Council and which budget is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", be and the same is in all things adopted and approved of all current expenditures/expenses as well as fixed charges against said City for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1998, and ending September 30, 1999.

SECTION 2. The sums below are hereby appropriated from the respective funds as revenues on behalf of the city government as established in the approved budget document for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1998, and ending September 30, 1999:

SECTION 3. (a) The sums below are hereby appropriated from the General Revenue Fund for the payment of expenditures on behalf of the city government as established in the approved budget document for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1998 and ending September 30, 1999

SECTION 4. That the sum of Sixty One Thousand, Six Hundred Ninety-One Dollars be appropriated from reserve funds to offset the deficit in the General Fund, contingent upon the Utility Fund receiving Grant funds from Water Tower project #716229.

SECTION 5. That the City Secretary/Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to make intra department fund transfers during the fiscal year as becomes necessary in order to avoid over expenditure of a particular account. Transfer of funds shall be approved by Department Heads prior to transfers being made.

SECTION 6. Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be and remain in full force from and after its final passage.

SECTION 8. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 10, of the Charter of the City of De Leon, the requirement for reading the Ordinance at two (2) meetings of the City Council is waived.
