

**ORDINANCE NO. # 012-03**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, PROVIDING THE ANTIQUE CAR MUSEUM WITH CITY WATER AND SEWER SERVICES; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS FOR SUCH USE AND RELATED MATTERS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS:**

- Section 1.** The City of De Leon, Texas, City Council has unanimously agreed to provide City water and wastewater services to the Antique Car Museum, located at 500 N. Texas Street, De Leon, Texas at no charge to the museum.
- Section 2.** The City of De Leon, Texas will provide the City services of water and wastewater to help promote the museum and the City of De Leon, Texas, as this will be included as part of the Texas Fort Trail as long as this museum is an active entity. Should the museum terminate business as a museum, the City of De Leon has the right to terminate or amend this ordinance.
- Section 3.** It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the *Open Meetings Act, Chapt. 511, Tex. Gov't Code*.
- Section 4.** This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption.
