Calling 811 is free and it's the law!

What is 811?



811 is the national toll-free telephone number that Congress enacted to prevent damages to underground utility lines caused by digging.

How does it work?



The 811 operator will ask questions about your project and will send professional line locators. The line locators will stake different colored flags or spray temporary paint to mark the path of underground utility-owned lines.

When should you call 811?



Everyone should call 811 before digging! If you're a homeowner planting a tree or an excavator digging foundations or landscaping, call 811 at least three business days before digging.

Why should you call 811?



Calling 811 is a fast, free and easy way to be safe and protect yourself from injury and loss of utility service. If you nick, scrape or dent a natural gas pipeline, call 911 and Atmos Energy's 24/7 emergency number 866-322-8667.
