## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of De Leon desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of De Leon to apply for funding under the 1987 Texas Community Development Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Community Development Program application for Community Development Project funding is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City of De Leon with the Texas Department of Commerce.
2. That the City's application be placed in competition for the funding under the Community Development Project Fund.
3. That the application be for \$ 153,448.00 of grant funds to carry out the administrative cost, engineering cost and paving improvements.
4. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Texas Community Development Program.
5. That the City of De Leon commit \$ 24,552.00 as a local match contribution from local sources as a cash, in-kind service, materials, supplies or land to be matched with Texas Community Development Project Funds to be used for administrative costs, engineering costs and paving improvements.
