ORDINANCE NO. 105-92

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, LEVYING TAXES FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1992, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1993; PROVIDING PENALTY AND INTEREST FOR DELINQUENT TAXES; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of De Leon, Texas, approved the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1992, and ending September 30, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the approved budget includes revenues in the amount of One Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$168,000.00) for the operation/maintenance of the City of De Leon; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, at this time, that said ordinance be passed levying tax on all property, both real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of De Leon, Texas, in accordance with such budget and all requirements have been complied with;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied, and these shall be collected for the operation and expense of the municipal government of the City of De Leon, Texas, for the year 1992 upon all property, both real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of De Leon, Texas, subject to taxation for the year 1992, a tax at the rate of Fifty Three Seventy Two Cents (.5372) on each One Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$100.00)

valuation of property to be assessed and collected for the purposes stipulated.

SECTION 2. The general laws of Texas, and particularly all the provisions of State of Texas Property Tax Code, and all amendments thereto, relating to the date of delinquency, penalties, interest, cost, and the collections of delinquent taxes, insofar as such provisions may be applicable in connection with the collection of all taxes assessed and levied by the City of De Leon, Texas, for the year 1992, are hereby referred to and adopted.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and shall remain in full force and effect from and after its final passage.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 11 of the Charter of the City of De Leon, Texas, the requirement for reading this ordinance at two (2) meetings of the City Council is waived.
