AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AS A PUBLIC STREET  
THAT PORTION OF HOUSTON STREET LYING BETWEEN  
BLOCKS 11 AND 12 OF THE ORIGINAL ADDITION TO  
THE CITY OF DE LEON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

Be It Ordained By The City Commission Of The City Of DeLeon:

Section 1: That the portion of Houston Street lying between Blocks 11 and ~~12~~ of the Original Addition to the City of DeLeon extending North and South from its intersection with Almante Street to its intersection with Bivar Street, as shown and designated on the official map of the City of DeLeon, having never been opened and used as a public street and being now needed for commercial development of the City, be and it is hereby abandoned and closed as a public street and thoroughfare.

Section 2: The fact that the portion of Houston Street lying between Blocks 11 and 12 of the Original Addition to the City of DeLeon has never been opened and used as a public street and is now needed for commercial development of the City, creates an emergency and imperative public necessity requiring the suspension of the rule that ordinances shall be read at three meetings of the City Commission. Said rule is therefore hereby suspended, and this ordinance is put upon its final reading and passed by a vote of 3 ayes and 0 nays.
