ORDINANCE NO. 75-~~100~~106 F

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF DE LEON ORDINANCE STYLED  
"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR FIRE LIMITS, AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING  
THE CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, REMOVAL, DEMOLITION, EQUIPMENT, USE  
AND OCCUPANCY, LOCATION AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of De Leon, Texas:

(1) SECTION NO. 1. ADOPTION OF BUILDING CODE.

The City Ordinance styled "An Ordinance providing for Fire Limits, and Regulations Governing the Construction, Alteration, Removal, Demolition, Equipment, Use and Occupancy, Location and Maintenance of Buildings and Structures" is hereby amended to provide in lieu of the adoption of the National Building Code, being particularly the 1967 abbreviated edition, as therein adopted to read "The latest edition of the National Building Code, save and except any portions thereof hereinafter deleted and adopting all modifications and Amendments thereto hereinafter made, and Section No. 1, adoption of Building Code of said Ordinance, as herein amended is hereby ratified and confirmed.

(2) SECTION NO. 4(a).

This section of the above named Ordinance is amended to provide a fee schedule for issuance of building permits. The building permits issued under the provisions of this ordinance will follow the most current fee schedule for permits as may be adopted by the City Council and will be placed on file in the City Secretary's office.

(3) As amended, all other provisions of said Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

(4) The City Council of the City of De Leon, Texas finding that the City of De Leon, Texas does not have an adequate Ordinance providing for adoption of the latest edition of the National Building Code and that this Ordinance should be adopted as an emergency Ordinance to give the protection to the citizens of the City of De Leon, Texas afforded by adoption of the latest edition of the National Building Code and that the requirement of several readings of this Ordinance should be dispensed with, and an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after date of its passage.
