

AN ORDINANCE ABANDONING CERTAIN CITY STREETS  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS

That WHEREAS a written proposal has been presented to the City Commission, by Ronald Boswell requesting the abandonment of portions of certain streets which adjoin Mr. Boswell's property between Bivar Street and Alamante Street;

That WHEREAS this proposal has been considered by the City Commission at two regular meetings;

That WHEREAS the City Commission is of the opinion that the abandonment of these certain streets which have never been opened nor used as thoroughfares of public commerce is in the best interest of the City, for the reason that the City will have to undertake the expense to open, establish and maintain streets in those localities, and the abandonment will serve the further public purpose of helping to promote the drainage of rain and other runoff waters from this area;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED to-wit: Effective immediately the City of De Leon, Texas hereby abandons the following unopened streets between Bivar Street (The Old Gorman Highway) and Alamante Street, and yields back the street easement to the adjacent landowner requesting said abandonment:

- 1) The West One Half of the South One Half of Famin Street;
- 2) The South One Half of Holland Street;
- 3) The South One Half of Johnson Street and the West One Half of the North One Half of Johnson Street;

EXCEPT, however, the abandonment of the aforesaid portions of Holland and Famin Streets is hereby limited to the extent needed by the City and the utility companies serving the City for the passage of lines of transmission for such utilities;

Alleys located in Blocks 14 and 15 of the Original Addition to the City of De Leon are not hereby abandoned, rather same are to be maintained for useage of rain and other runoff water drainage from the subject premises and surrounding areas.
