

AN ORDINANCE
PROHIBITING THE CONNECTION OF SEWER LINES OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS; PROVIDING
FOR APPLICATION FOR SAID SERVICES; EXEMPTIONS TO SAID ORDINANCE:

SECTION I: That all sewer lines outside the city limits be prohibited
as of the 23rd day of October, 1984.

SECTION II: Any person, partnership or corporation desiring to use the
city services shall make a written application to the city
council and said council shall have the power either to
grant or reject such application.

SECTION III: EXEMPTION CLAUSE; Any person, partnership or corporation using
the city services upon adoption of this ordinance shall be
exempt from the provisions herein.

SECTION IV: SAVING CLAUSE; The board of City Commissioners of the City of
De Leon, Texas hereby declares that if any section, sentence,
clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid
or imperative for any reason by a court of competent jurisdic-
tion, that it would have passed any or all of the remaining
portions of this ordinance without the exclusion of that part
which may be found unconstitutional, or invalid or imperative
for any reason and declares that its intent is to make no part
of this ordinance dependent upon the validity of any part thereof;
and that the remaining and valid portions of said ordinance shall
be and remain in full force and effect.
