

ORDINANCE NO. 90-105

AN ORDINANCE SETTING SPEED LIMITS ON STATE 16 WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DELEON, TEXAS; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY IN ANY AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR CONVICTION OF VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by an engineering and traffic investigation that the maximum, reasonable, and prudent speeds for the section of State 16 described, are herein below set out and as shown on the attached plan;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DELEON, TEXAS, that from and after final passage of this Ordinance and publication thereof, as required by the charter of the City of DeLeon, and the posting of appropriate speed zone signs, and the following speed zones are established, the maximum speed permitted therein shall be as herein set forth:

On State 16 from its intersection with State 6, at Mile Point 0.008, to Mile Point 1.384, the South City Limits of DeLeon; the maximum speed for both directions of travel shall be as follows:

On State 16 from its intersection with State 6, at Mile Point 0.008 to Mile Point 0.290 for a distance of 0.282 miles, 35 Miles Per Hour; from this point to Mile Point 0.770 for a distance of 0.480 miles, 30 Miles Per Hour; from this point to Mile Point 1.084 for a distance of 0.314 miles, 35 Miles Per Hour; and from this point to Mile Point 1.384, the South City Limits of DeLeon, for a distance of 0.300 miles, 45 Miles Per Hour. All as evidenced by the attached Speed Zone Plan dated May 8, 1989;

EXCEPT that the maximum speed limit for the School Zone located in the above designated sections shall be as follows: From Station 18+88 to Station 29+78, 20 Miles Per Hour. This School Zone Speed shall be applicable only on school days at intervals of time during the day when children may be crossing State 16 (Texas Street) in going to and from school. These intervals of time shall be determined by the appropriate city and school officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DELEON, TEXAS, hereby declares and fixes the maximum, reasonable, and prudent speed limit to be as shown on the attached plan. This order cancels and supersedes any existing Ordinance setting speed limits on the above limits.

PENALTY: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, fined in an amount not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
