

ORDINANCE NO. 010-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING "ONE-WAY" TRAFFIC, FROM NORTH TO SOUTH, ON SOUTH LAMAR STREET, STARTING FROM THE INTERSECTION OF EAST AYERS AND SOUTH LAMAR AND ENDING AT THE INTERSECTION OF EAST PECAN AND SOUTH LAMAR, DURING DE LEON ISD SCHOOL HOURS, 7:00 A.M. – 8:30 A.M & 2:30 P.M.- 4:00 P.M., MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY; PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) FOR CONVICTION OF ANY VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; WAIVER OF 2 READINGS CLAUSE; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, that South Lamar Street, starting from the intersection of East Ayers Street and South Lamar and ending at the intersection of East Pecan Street and South Lamar, is hereby designated and established for "one-way" traffic only, from North to South, during De Leon ISD school hours, 7:00 a.m.-8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. – 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

PENALTY: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, fined in an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00).


SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: If any section, subsection, phrase, sentence, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SAVINGS CLAUSE: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed. The balance of such ordinance is hereby saved from repeal.

WAIVER OF 2 READINGS: That this Ordinance is enacted without the benefit of two readings because it was enacted by an affirmative vote of all members of the City Council in accordance with Article VII, Section 10 of the City Charter.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage and publication thereof as required by the Charter of the City of De Leon, Texas, and installation of proper signs.
