## RESOLUTION NO. 05-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE ELECTION RESULTS FOR THE MAY 4, 2019 SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE FOLLOWING PROPOSITION: PROPOSITION NO. 1 – THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF DE LEON AT THE RATE OF ONE-FOURTH OF ONE PERCENT TO CONTINUE PROVIDING REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF THE MUNICIPAL STREETS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of De Leon, Texas ordered a special election to be held on May 4, 2019 (the "Election") to consider passage of Proposition No. 1, the purpose of which was to determine whether the voters of the City of De Leon, Texas desire to reauthorize a local sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets pursuant to Texas Tax Code, Chapter 327.001 et. seq.;

**WHEREAS,** the Texas Election Code provides that each local canvassing authority shall convene not earlier than May 7, 2019 or later than May 15, 2019 for the purpose of canvassing the election results; and

**WHEREAS,** the Texas Election Code also provides that only two (2) members of the City Council are needed and constitute a quorum for the purpose of canvassing election results; and

**WHEREAS,** a quorum of the City Council met on Thursday, May 9, 2019 and duly canvassed the election returns of the Election and finds that there were a total of 204 valid and legal votes cast in the Election.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this resolution as if fully set forth herein.

**SECTION 2.** The official canvass of the returns of the Election held on May 4, 2019, reflect that the following proposition received the number of votes set forth below:

## **Proposition No. 1**

"The reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of De Leon at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. The tax expires on the fourth anniversary of the date of this election unless the imposition of this tax is reauthorized."

**SECTION 3.** The official canvass of the returns of the Election held on May 4, 2019 reflect that Proposition No. 1 passed by 138 votes and was duly adopted by the voters of the City of De Leon, Texas.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution is enacted without the benefit of two readings because it was enacted by an affirmative vote of all members of the City Council in accordance with Article VII, Section 10 of the City Charter.
