

RESOLUTION NO. 012-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, DETERMINING THAT COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSALS IS THE PROCUREMENT METHOD THAT PROVIDES THE BEST VALUE TO THE CITY IN THE PURCHASE OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF LAMAR STREET PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of De Leon, Texas (the “City”) desires to procure and construct LAMAR STREET (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2269 of the Government Code provides that if the City is selecting a procurement method other than competitive sealed bids, before it sends out the notice for procurement, the City Council must make a finding that the contemplated method of procurement provides the “best value” to the City for that project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines and finds that competitive sealed proposals is the procurement method that provides the “best value” to the City in the procurement and construction of the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds that the premises and findings set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby determines and finds that competitive sealed proposals is the procurement method that provides the “best value” to the City in the procurement and construction of LAMAR STREET.

Section 3. That this Resolution is enacted without the benefit of two readings because it was enacted by an affirmative vote of all members of the City Council in accordance with Article VII, Section 10 of the City Charter.
