1. Mention was made during job walk to include CDBG forms due with proposal submittal. Please clarify which CDBG forms (via exhibit or page number from specifications) are required to be submitted with proposal.

2. Bid solicitation does not clarify all forms that are required to be submitted with bid, please provide list of bid forms required to be submitted with proposal.

City Response: See Bid Forms on Page 70 of the Specifications.

3. Plan sheet SG-3 notes details for new VFD for splash pad and to field test if required flow rates can be achieved, please confirm that specified VFD in plans and specifications is assumed to meet required flow rates.

ADG: Contractor to field verify motor condition, manufacturer, and capacity and provide submittal for a new VFD that meets the requirements listed in specification 13 11 06.

4. Plan sheet SG-3 notes "provide and install new impellor as necessary" for existing spray ground feature pump, please clarify if this replacement is intended to be included in base bid or as a potential change order once determined to be required.

ADG: Contractor to provide Owner with change order in the event the pump impeller needs to be replaced.

5. Plan sheet SG-3 notes "provide and install new impellor as necessary" for existing spray ground feature pump, please provide full pump manufacturer, model, and specification details for sizing and correct compatibility of new impeller from vendors as this information is required my manufacturers for pricing.

10. Plan sheet SP-3 notes "TP-GEN7-10" timing system. This system is for 10 lane timing, current pool and design layout only has 8 lane timing system, please clarify.

ADG: SP-3 sheet note states to provide deck poxes wall plate boxes and all conduit for future scoreboard system.

11. Plan sheet SP-3 notes 10 judging platforms, while there are only 8 timing lanes please clarify.

ADG: SP-3 sheet note states to provide deck poxes wall plate boxes and all conduit for future scoreboard system.

12. Please provide as builds or provide assumed thickness of existing deck to determine costs of demolition and disposal.

ADG: Assume the deck is generally 6" thick SOG and 9" at cantilever and thickened at deck drain features.

13.Plan sheet DP1-1 note 7 references a "soils report". Please clarify as there was no geotechnical soils report included in bid documents that only plan notes are to followed.

City Response: This is correct. No geotechnical soils report was included in the bid documents. Bidders should refer to the project plans and specifications.

14. Plan sheet DP-1 note 9 states repair of crack and rust spots. Please provide linear footage of cracks and square footage area of rust spot repair to carry as an allowance for bidding as these conditions are unknown until existing plaster is removed and structural shell can be evaluated.

ADG: Assume 50 square feet of rust repair in pool shell and provide square foot cost schedule of values for additional repair. Assume 50 liner feet of crack repair and provide liner foot cost in schedule of values.

21. Please provide current chemical storage tank sizing (liquid chlorine, liquid acid, and Co2 tank size [if present]) to determine pricing of full chemical systems for owner turnover.

ADG: Chlorine - 1000 Gallon Acid - 500 Gallon
