

GET TESTED FOR COVID-19!



THOSE WHO TEST POSITIVE CAN HELP SLOW THE SPREAD OF COVID-19
BY ISOLATING THEMSELVES TO REDUCE THE CHANCES OF INFECTING
OTHERS AND TO KEEP FAMILY, FRIENDS, AND COLLEAGUES SAFE.

When should you get tested?

- · If you have symptoms
 - Vaccinated or not, get tested immediately.
- If you were exposed
 - Fully vaccinated people should get tested on day 5 of exposure or after.
 - Unvaccinated or partially vaccinated people should test immediately, and again on day 5 of exposure or after.
- If you travel
 - Vaccinated or not, anyone entering or re-entering California should test 3-5 days after arrival.
 - All travelers arriving in or returning to California from other states or countries should follow <u>CDC travel guidance</u>.
