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City of Desert Hot Springs Engineering Department Grading Policy

Date Issued: September 29, 2022

Effective: Immediately

Effective September 29, 2022, the City of Desert Hot Springs shall be implementing the following grading policy for all projects throughout the City. A grading permit shall be required from the Engineering Department for any grading operations if any one of the following conditions exist or will be created:

- 1. Any fill, excavation or moving of dirt that exceeds 25-cubic yards on any one lot.
- 2. An excavation, which is: (1) more than 2-feet in depth or (2) an excavation, which creates a cut slope greater than 3-feet in height and steeper than two horizontal to one vertical (2:1).
- 3. A fill, which is: (1) greater than 1-foot in depth and placed on terrain with a natural slope flatter than 5 horizontal to 1 vertical, or (2) greater than 3-feet in depth, regardless of the natural terrain on which it is placed, which is intended to support structures.
- 4. Any back fill of an excavation, the purpose of which is the removal of an existing underground structure, such as an underground fuel storage tank, or basement.
- 5. Any over excavation and re-compaction of a building site, which exceeds 3-feet in depth in accordance with the recommendations of a soils engineering report.

This shall not exempt any fill made with the material from such excavation nor attempt any excavation having an unsupported height greater than 3-feet after the completion of such structure.
