All active registered voters will automatically receive a vote-by-mail

ballot for the November 8, 2022, General Election. Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by November 8, 2022; ballots returned at a secure ballot drop box must be deposited by 8:00 pm on November 8, 2022.

Make sure to cast your vote on November 5 through 7th from 8:00 am to 5:pm or on Election Day, November 8, from 7:00 am through 9:00 pm.
