"CITY OF DESERT HOT SPRINGS ANNOUNCES ROAD REPAIR ESTIMATES POST TROPICAL STORM HILARY"

Desert Hot Springs, November 09, 2023: On Tuesday, November 7, 2023, the Desert Hot Springs City Council approved critical repair contracts for multiple roadways that were destroyed by Tropical Storm Hillary. This approval signals a significant advancement in the city's recovery efforts.

The following locations, damaged on August 20th, are set for repair:

- 1. Pierson Blvd. Bridge at Mission Creek
- 2. Dillon Road at Mission Creek
- 3. Little Morongo Road at Mission Creek
- 4. Indian Canyon Road at Mission Creek

Immediate action and post-damage assessments led to a swift response, with redesign efforts and planning beginning just two days after the event. On October 18, 2023, the city issued Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for the road repairs. Each of the various repair locations received multiple proposals from various contractors.

On November 7th, the City Council took a decisive step by awarding construction contracts to the lowest and most responsive bidders. The estimated start date for construction is November 20th, with a completion window stretching from January 1st to April 20th, 2024. Residents are reminded that these dates are provisional and hinge on Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) approval and other regulatory considerations.

In a proactive measure, the city has lodged reimbursement requests to both Caltrans and the FHWA for emergency repair relief funding. The commencement of repairs is contingent upon these approvals, as well as on utility relocations, environmental clearances, and interagency approvals.

The City Council and staff are dedicated to restoring full functionality to these vital roadways and ensuring the safety and mobility of all residents. We appreciate the community's patience and support during these times of rebuilding.
