Arrests Made in Mailbox Theft

Desert Hot Springs, February 7, 2024:

On Sunday, January 28, 2024, the Desert Hot Springs Police Department received a report of a large community mailbox stolen in the Hacienda Heights neighborhood. A witness was able to record the theft and provided that video to police. Detectives assumed the investigation and identified a suspect. On Monday, February 5, 2024, the suspect was taken into custody in the area of Palm Drive and Desert View Avenue without incident. Detectives also served a search warrant related to this investigation and located numerous pieces of stolen mail. The suspect was booked into the Riverside County Jail in Indio on this case, as well as an unrelated case. A female passenger was also taken into custody on unrelated warrants for her arrest.
