- Project Process Expanding outreach to communities not normally engaged
- Digital Marin is not a County of Marin project. We're looking for co-equal collaborations between municipalities, districts, and agencies.
- Direct our approach to gathering input:

- Help to ID other agencies and how to get in touch with them (What are we missing?)
