Mayor Larsen announced several upcoming holiday events. Weather permitting, the Santa Parade will be held on December 3, 2022 at 11:00 am, followed by the Hook Mill tree lighting at 4:30. The tree lighting is sponsored by Prada, who donated \$30,000 towards the holiday festivities. On December 10th Santa Clause will be arriving by helicopter in Herrick Park at noon. There will be a free viewing of *Polar Express* with a small popcorn & soda for the first 250 people, at the Regal Cinema. On December 18th at 3:30 the first night of Hanukkah will be celebrated with the menorah lighting at Hook Mill with the Chabad of the Hamptons. On December 19th at 5 pm the 2nd night on Hanukkah will be celebrated with the menorah lighting at Hook Mill with the Jewish Center of the Hamptons.


2023 Seasonal Beach Parking Pass Pricing

The Board briefly discussed the price and sale of the 2023 Non-Resident Beach Parking Permits. Non-resident permits will be available to purchase at \$500 each at the Emergency Services Building at 1 Cedar Street, in-person only, on January 27, 2023 from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. This will be a one-day in-person only sale of the permits, with a limit of one permit per transaction. At the December 16th meeting the Board will adopt a resolution setting the price of the 2023 non-resident beach parking permits at \$750 each for the available balance of the 3100 permits, which will be available to purchase online only starting February 1, 2023.

Mayor Larsen thanked the East Hampton Press for including the mill in their holiday magazine.

Upon the motion of Deputy Mayor Minardi and seconded by Trustee Doyle the Board unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting at 11:17 a.m.
