- Cuts curbs and sets forms;
- Cleans and makes minor repairs to lift stations;

- Monitors computer systems;
- Works with planting, edging, pruning, trimming, seeding, spraying, fertilizing and related activities pertaining to the cleaning and maintenance of rights-of-way and other public grounds;

- Repairs and replaces signs according to the Uniform Traffic Manual;
- Enforces safety regulations;
