

Recipients of this award display loyalty, dependability, high moral and ethical standards, all while demonstrating awareness and sensitivity to the victims.

Chief McFarland stated "State's Attorney Jones approaches each case with a profound understanding of the impact of crime on individuals and the community. He fosters trust and confidence in the legal system and has created positive relationships with local law enforcement agencies".
