PICK UP/DROP OFF PROCEDURES

Drop Off & Pick Up	:
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Children are bussed after school from Middle School South, Middle School North, and St. Francis de Sales to the Teen Room located in the Foglia YMCA. Children are required to present a bus pass to the bus drivers to utilize this transportation service. Ela Township will provide your child with a bus pass after their registration has been confirmed. For pick up, authorized adults (parents/guardians, baby sitters, etc.) are required to enter the building to sign out their children. Authorized adults may use the doorway connected directly to the Teen Room (Door 19) during pick up. This doorway is located to the right of the main doors and down a curved stairway. The door is electronically locked and you must ring the bell to be let in or out.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

Behavior Expectations:

The following behavior expectations are in effect at all Ela Township Youth Department programs. Ela Township Youth staff may develop more expectations as they pertain to individual programs.

- * Children take responsibility for their actions.
- * Children respect themselves, other children and staff, and program equipment and environment.
- * Children participate in program activities to the best of their ability.

Program Dismissal:

Ela Township has the right to dismiss any child whose behavior, attitude, or action is, in our judgment, contrary to the best interests of our program community. This includes but is not limited to: destruction of property, excessive fighting or other aggressive behavior, harassment, bullying, sexual behavior, theft, excessive disobedience, or for other conduct that is ruining another child's experience or is harmful to the program. Ela Township will not dismiss any child without first consulting with the child's parent.

Student Behavior Contract

Behavior

Children are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. The following guidelines have been established to ensure the program is safe and enjoyable for all participants.

- 1. Show respect to all participants and staff.
- 2. Treat others as you would like to be treated.
- 3. Refrain from using profanities and/or derogatory language/nonverbal expressions.
- 4. Physical aggression toward all participants and/or staff is prohibited.
- 5. Do not destroy or damage equipment and supplies.
- 6. Participants are expected to do as they are asked, upon the first request.
- 7. Maintain an appropriate voice level in Teen Room and a respectful volume when in hallways and in common spaces.
- 8. CHARACTER COUNTS!

Discipline

In the event participants do not adhere to the established rules and guidelines, the following disciplinary procedures will be followed. Ela Township reserves the right to bypass one or all steps listed below based on the severity of the infraction.

- 1st warning Timeout and/or loss of privilege (i.e.: screen time, gym, games, etc.)
- 2nd warning A child will receive only one verbal warning and/or timeout per day. A behavior ticket will automatically accompany the second warning and/or timeout.
- Any child who receives three behavior tickets within a two-week time period, or by supervisor's discretion, will receive an immediate one-day suspension from the program.
- · If a child receives two more additional behavior tickets during the remainder of the program, an immediate three-day suspension from the program will be applied.
- · After a child receives a three-day suspension, the next behavior ticket will result in expulsion from the program.
- Immediate suspension or expulsion from Teen Club will result from severe disregard of the rules including, but not limited to: physical, aggressive behavior to others, damaging property, or theft.

Student Behavior Contract

Electronics

Electronic devices may only be used for homework or to contact a parent or guardian, with permission, before screen time begins. Screen time will begin at 4:00 each day. There will be NO violent video or computer games allowed at Teen Club. This includes games rated T (ESRB), like Fortnite.

YMCA Facilities

- Pool—must use family locker room to change.
- Gym—during free time only provided balls may be used. There is zero tolerance for the use of any equipment, including sitting on the mats.
- Teen Club participants must use the family locker room or the restrooms opposite the registration desk. Use of the other locker rooms is prohibited.

Upon signing this document, both the parent and student agree to the guidelines set forth, and will abide by the discipline actions issued if this contract is not followed.

- I will be respectful of the other students and all Ela and YMCA staff. This means that I will speak to others in a respectful manner and tone of voice.
- I will follow all directions.
- I will not threaten or cause physical harm towards others, including possessing sharp or other dangerous instruments.
- I will respect the personal space of others and keep my body to myself.
- I understand that disrespectful behavior includes, but is not limited to, hitting, punching, kicking, biting, spitting, swearing, lying, and refusing to listen to the Ela staff.
- I will be respectful of the Foglia YMCA and Ela Township property.
- I will not litter, vandalize, steal, or destroy items that do not belong to me.
- * I agree to follow all program rules including those that are not listed on this behavior agreement or rules set forth program staff.
