Meeting Minutes – Approved August 11, 2022

This meeting will be conducted by audio or video conference and may not have a physically present quorum of the Ela Township Board because of a disaster declaration related to COVID-19 public health concerns affecting the Township. Pursuant to Section 7(e)(2) of the Open Meetings Act, the Supervisor has determined that an in-person meeting at the Township building with all participants is not practical or prudent because of the disaster. Township officials, legal counsel, and the Township Manager will not be physically present at the Township Hall, if that is unfeasible due to the disaster. Since physical public attendance at the Township Hall may be limited or not feasible, alternative arrangements for public access to hear the meeting has been made available by contacting the Supervisor's Office at (847) 438-7823 for the Zoom meeting link or the phone number to call into the meeting prior to 8:15a.m. on July 27, 2022.

- 1. <u>Call to Order:</u> Supervisor Palmblad called the July 27, 2022 Committee of the Whole meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.
- Board Roll Call: Present were Supervisor Palmblad, Clerk Prouty, Trustee Bowman, Trustee Sikes joined at 8:37 a.m., Trustee Ufodike, Trustee Wilhoit, Assessor Herr, Highway Superintendent DePouw, Community Programs Director Dillon, Director Marx, Highway Foreman Meyer, and Management Assistant Snyder.
- 3. <u>Pledge of Allegiance</u>: Supervisor Palmblad led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 4. Discussion Updates by Chair:
 - a. <u>Community Center Committee</u> Chair/Trustee Ufodike Members: Supervisor Palmblad, Trustee Wilhoit, Director Dillon, Assistant Director Dalbec, Youth Coordinator Cacciatore Director Dillon reported that there will be no Teen Club this semester, due to lack of transportation. Chef Corey is adjusting to his new role very well. Not only is he frugal, he is also a good cook. Unfortunately, there are a lot of staff out with Covid 19. Revenue from the Danube River Trip was \$30,000.00. The October, November, December 55+ Newsletter is ready to be mailed out.
 - b. <u>Communication Committee</u> Chair/Supervisor Palmblad Members: Assessor Herr, Director Dillon, Director Marx, Assistant Director Dalbec, and Staff Supervisor Palmblad reported that the Fall ET Newsletter will go out after November 8, 2022 General Election. Articles are due to Administrative Coordinator Case on September 12, 2022 and it will be on the agenda for board approval in October. The outdoor fitness court will be installed on Monday August 1, 2022. The committee is in the beginning stages of planning a ribbon cutting event to take place in early fall.
