Drop Off & Pick Up:

Participants should be dropped off and picked up inside the main entrance of the Ela Township Community Center. Participants must be accompanied by an authorized adult (parent/guardian, baby sitter adult, etc.) to/from the Community Center for drop off/pick up, as we require participants to be signed in/out by their authorized adult.

The Ela Township Winter Break Camp program ends promptly at 4:30 pm

A \$5.00 fee will be assessed for late pickups. Up to the first 15 minutes is \$5.00 and an additional \$5.00 for every 5 minutes thereafter.

Behavior Expectations:

The following behavior expectations are in effect at all Ela Township Youth Department programs. Ela Township Youth staff may develop more expectations as they pertain to individual programs.

Ela Township will not dismiss any child without first consulting with the child's parent.
