To Fairfax Town Council Members,

I am writing to you as a resident of Marin County, and a concerned Muslim-American community member. Please vote YES on the Peace Proclamation and support a Ceasefire Now. As someone who has lived in Marin my entire life, I am so pleased to hear that Fairfax City Council is the first city in all of Marin County to acknowledge the humanity of Palestinians while they continue to be indiscriminately carpet-bombed and killed in the Gaza strip.

Islamophobia is on the rise within our country, posing a significant threat to the well-being and safety of our diverse communities and all Americans. As a Muslim-American, I am concerned about living in a County that prides itself in progressive values but consciously ignores the blatant violations of international law the Israeli military is committing while Palestinians in Gaza suffer catastrophic daily loss.

The Gaza genocide is an urgent humanitarian disaster that requires immediate international attention. After enduring a 16-year economic blockade imposed by the Israeli government and the evasion of Int, the people of Gaza now face the open threat of ethnic cleansing and genocide.

Since October 7, more than 36,000 people have been killed including more than 15,000 children. Per the United Nations, the situation unfolding in Gaza is an "appalling and unprecedented humanitarian disaster" with 90% of the population displaced, 60% of the infrastructure destroyed and only 25% of hospitals functioning with very little supplies. Gaza's 2.3 million population is on the brink of starvation.

How many more children and innocent people have to die before our government acts?

As U.S. citizens and Marin County residents, our tax contributions fund this atrocity, imparting upon us a direct responsibility to implore our elected officials to refrain from financing Israel's continuing pursuits of genocide, apartheid, and occupation.

A ceasefire resolution urges the United States to reassert its leadership role as a negotiator, addressing the root causes of violence, and ending Israel's occupation and apartheid policies. As global citizens, it remains our moral duty to consistently advocate for peace and justice wherever they are needed in the world.

This letter is not asking you to ignore the suffering of Israelis and it in no way condones violence perpetrated on civilians. I do, however, implore you to acknowledge the loss of lives and recognize humanity on both sides as all human life is precious.

Fairfax City Council, I wholeheartedly support any and every effort put into a ceasefire resolution. Vote yes. Be on the right side of history.

**Re: "Proclamation of Peace" on the Town Council's June 5, 2024 meeting agenda**

Dear Town Council members,

This office serves as counsel to individual members of the community, and on their behalf, reviewed the "Proclamation of Peace" currently before the Town Council. I write to you in your capacity as Town Council members.

In our opinion, there are legal risks to Fairfax should the Town adopt the Proclamation of Peace. These risks arise from both the substance of the proclamation and its form. There is time and opportunity for the Town to avoid the consequences of adopting the proclamation. The Town should reject it.

---

First and foremost, the proclamation exacerbates divisions in the town, alienating Jewish and pro-Israel residents at best, and promoting their harassment and violence against them at worst. For instance, it uses the term "Palestine," a term that is undefined and that is used by Jihadists, Hamas, and other entities and nations intent on annihilation of the State of Israel. It calls for entry of "humanitarian assistance into Gaza" as if that is the responsibility of anyone other than Hamas, the government of Gaza that is supported by the vast majority of those who live in Gaza. It omits calling for humanitarian assistance into Israel, which has been, and continues to be attacked by Hamas, Hezbollah, Syria, and Iran, as well as from terrorists entering from Jordan and Judea and Samaria. The proclamation does not call for the elimination of Hamas, a horrible U.S.-designated terrorist organization. The proclamation fails to call on all countries, including Iran, and those who call themselves Palestinians (whether in Gaza or elsewhere), to end their stated goal of eliminating the State of Israel and killing Jewish people. The proclamation fails to call for the destruction of the terror infrastructure in

Gaza. The proclamation fails to call for the de-funding of UNWRA. While purporting to promote peace, the proclamation promotes antisemitism, Judeophobia, racism, discrimination, hatred, and violence against Jewish and Israeli persons.

The purpose of the proclamation, a focus on Israel, is itself discriminatory and antisemitic. Moreover, without denouncing Hamas, the Hamas charter and the objectives of those who are intent on the destruction of Israel, your proclamation is antisemitic, Judeophobic, and unlawfully discriminatory. The proclamation is an attempt to appease those whose agenda is the annihilation of the State of Israel, and the persecution and killing of Jewish persons everywhere.

Those who have pressured the Town of Fairfax into creating and considering the proclamation will not stop if you adopt it. Instead, you will have created precedent for the loud and hateful to pressure you into additional hateful, discriminatory, antisemitic, and unlawful legislation, be it divestment, indoctrination of children, or anything else. The Town will demonstrate that it is willing to become a tool for anti-Israel, anti-Zionist, and Judeophobic hate mongers.

Fairfax Town Code Section 2.08.090 (B) does not shield the Town, or you individually, from becoming defendants in a lawsuit, if the proclamation is adopted. Town codes do not supersede state or federal law. Pursuant to the dormant foreign affairs doctrine, levels of government below the federal government, including cities, have no authority to adopt attitudes about foreign affairs. On foreign affairs our country speaks with one voice, through our federal government, and not through individual localities. Your proclamation is precisely the type of policy, attitude, or statement that a town or city is precluded from making.

Furthermore, all State governments within our United States of America are obligated by law to respect the sovereignty of other nations. Accordingly, Fairfax would be overreaching its authority with the proclamation, which “calls” for an “end to violent conflict” by the government or State of Israel (or any other government). You have no jurisdiction to tell the State of Israel what it should do.

The conflict between Hamas (and those who act in the interests of Hamas and its supporters) and the other powers who are intent on the destruction of the State of Israel is fundamentally a religious conflict. The State of Israel, with Jewish people living in their own ancestral Land of Israel and governing themselves, is not only based on the thousands of years of Jewish presence in that land, but also in Judaism. It is a basic tenet of Judaism. Islamic theology contradicts that. In calling any part of the Land of Israel “Palestine,” your proclamation promotes Islamic theology and discriminates against Judaism. This is unconstitutional, unlawful, and immoral.

No one elected any of you to promulgate foreign policy. The Town of Fairfax does not have a diplomatic corps, does not have military intelligence, does not engage in multilateral foreign relations. The Town of Fairfax, no matter what its code says, has no authority on matters of foreign relations, foreign affairs, or foreign policy. A town cannot grant itself powers that the federal government reserves for itself. Indeed, the Town of Fairfax has no jurisdiction to adopt any policy that is in conflict with federal policy, as the proclamation does.

Neither the council nor you as individuals have authority to represent the citizens or even the residents of Fairfax on foreign affairs. Not every person who has urged you to adopt a “ceasefire” resolution or the “peace proclamation” that you’ve crafted, lives in Fairfax. Indeed, you are precluded by law from inquiring where those who speak to you live or if they are voters. Thus, while you might imagine that your proclamation represents the “will” of your residents, you have no knowledge of whether it does. The proclamation simply represents the views of those who wrote it, and some of the views of those who push for it.

As a town that is committed to the safety, dignity, freedom, and equality of all, when it comes to a war taking place abroad, the “conflict” or however you choose to call it between Israel and its surrounding countries or terrorists, you must stay absolutely neutral. Any position you take will negatively affect the safety, dignity, freedom, and equality of some. Your proclamation negatively impacts the safety, dignity, freedom, and equality of Jewish and Israeli persons.

The proclamation simply recites reasons for taking a political position on the war between Israel and Hamas as Israel responds to an attack by Hamas. Whatever one’s views are about the politics of the region, there is no predicate justifying making any proclamation about that issue – and every reason to fear that the proclamation will diminish the safety, dignity, freedom, equality, and peace of the residents of Fairfax and neighboring areas.

Any affected person could bring a claim under U.S. and California law against Fairfax.

The environment is primed for conflict. The proclamation adds a spark. In a town in which the public is comprised of those who identify with Israel and those who identify with Gaza, Palestinians, or Hamas, the proclamation will exacerbate differences rather than encouraging empathy, tolerance, or understanding.

Thank you for listening to our community; I can tell that you put much thought into the wording.

I have seen that the proclamation has been reported in the Media and it is sure to attract many who, unfortunately, like using the suffering of Palestinians to justify their hatred of Jews. It is sure to include demonizing rhetoric and even justification of the targeting of incidents and Hamas's brutal rape, torture, and murder (as one speaker did in last meeting).

Additionally, this will encourage such people to put more effort to continue their behavior in other towns across Marin.

I understand that for many of you, you are trying to just make the world better but please understand that for the Jewish community, this is not theory: this is real. Your actions have consequences.

I therefore urge you to not pass this resolution.
